Tasks of fire service

Utilizing the available facilities and human resources,

fire service shall protect the lives, physical being and

property of the public from fire, and take precautions against disasters such as storms, floods, fires and

earthquakes, while mitigating the damage of these

disasters. Fire service is also responsible for the

appropriate transport of persons who have sustained

injuries due to a disaster. (Fire and Disaster Management Organization Act, Clause 1)
